NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by proviso to Article-309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the existing recruitment rules for the post mentioned herein, the Governor hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Inspector of Factories, Group-A, Gazetted under the Factories & Boilers Organisation, Government of Tripura, namely:-

1. Short title & commencement: -

(1) These rules may be called Recruitment Rules for the post of Inspector of Factories, Group - A, Gazetted under the Factories & Boilers Organisation, Government of Tripura.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of its publication in the official Gazette.

2. The name of the post(s) has been specified in Column-1 of the Schedule Annexed hereto.

3. Number, Classification and Scale of pay: -

The number of the said post, its classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in Column - 2 to 4 of the schedule annexed hereto.

4. Method of recruitment, age limit, qualification, etc.:-

The method of recruitment to the said post, age limits, qualifications and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in column 5 to 13 of the said schedule.

5. Disqualification: -

No person -

(a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or,

(b) Who, having a spouse living has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person shall be eligible for appointment to the said post.

Provided that the State Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the Personal Law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

6. Power to relax : Where the State Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient to do so, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in



writing and in consultation with the "Tripura Public Service Commission", relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of person.

7. Repeal and Saving :-

- (i) The Recruitment Rules for the post of Inspector of Factories under Labour Dept. (Factories & Boilers Organisation) vide Notification No. F. 2(311)-FB/ESTT/08/410-28, dated 15th May, 2023 is hereby repealed.
- (ii) Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concession required to be provided for the Scheduled Caste, the Scheduled Tribes, Ex-Servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with orders issued by the State Government from time to time in this regard.
- (iii) Nothing such repeal any appointment made or order issued, action taken or anything what so ever done under the rules repealed shall be deem to have been made, issued, taken or done under the corresponding provision of these rules.

8. Interpretation:- If any question arises as to the interpretation of these rules, it shall be referred to the Home Department, Government of Tripura, whose decision thereon shall be final and binding.

9. This Notification is issued as per approval of the Council of Ministers vide Memo. No. F.1(12)-GA(CAB)/2001-A dated, 19.04.2023.



1. Name of the Post	:	Inspector of Factories.	
2. Number of post(s)	:	4(four) plus additional post(s) as and when created.	
3. Classification	:	Group – A, Gazetted.	
4. Scale of Pay	:	Pre-revised Scale of pay	Corresponding revised Scale of Pay
	:	Pay Band-4, Pay Band Scale Rs.13,575-37,000/-(Grade Pay Rs.4,800/-)	Cell-1 of Level 16 of Tripura State Pay Matrix, 2018. [Tripura State Civil Service (Revised Pay) (First Amendment) Rules, 2018] and subject to revision by the Government from time to time.
5. Method of recruitment Whether by direct recruitment or by promotion or transfer on deputation and percentage of the vacancies to be filled by various methods.	:	By direct recruitment failing which by transfer on deputation. For direct recruitment: (i) selection shall be through competitive written examination to be conducted by the TPSC. (ii) the candidates declared qualified in the written test shall have to appear for Interview. Interview shall be not exceeding 15% of the total marks. (iii) the merit list shall be prepared on the basis of mark secured in the written test as well as Interview. (iv) educational qualification & experience are in Sl. No. 7 of this Schedule. (v) syllabus of examination is annexed with this Schedule as ' Annexure-A ' (and as revised by the Government from time to time). Transfer on deputation is in Sl.11.	
6. Age limit for direct recruitment.	:	Up to 40 years. Relaxable by 5(five) years in case of ST/SC candidates and Government Servant candidates.

Educational and other qualifications required for direct recruitment.	<p>Essential:</p> <p>i) At least a Bachelor Degree in Mechanical or Electrical or Chemical Engineering from a recognized University or equivalent.</p> <p>ii) Minimum 6(six) years experience in production/ maintenance/ Safety Departments in factory of repute.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Or,</p> <p>Minimum 5(five) years experience in a responsible position in factories inspection works under the Directorate of Factories of any State / Central government.</p> <p>iii) Permanent Resident Certificate of Tripura (PRTC) would be required while applying for jobs by direct recruitment under the State Government.</p> <p>Power to relax: Where the State Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient to do so, it may relax the provision as mentioned above in Sl.(iii) with respect to any class or category of persons or Posts.</p> <p>Desirable:</p> <p>Knowledge of Bengali or Kokborok.</p> <p>Note: (Experience relaxable at Commission's discretion in case of candidate is otherwise well qualified).</p>


